Health Department announces additional flu shot clinics

The Oklahoma City-County Health Department has planned 11 public clinics through the Oklahoma County area for influenza immunizations. These clinics will be held based upon the anticipated delivery schedule of the vaccine by the suppliers. Immunizations are open to the public and are available for everyone over six months of age.
