Parenting workshop – How Personality Type Affects Parenting Style

Did you know there is no one right way to be a good parent? In a three session class parents will discover their personality type and how it affects their parenting style. The classes will be held at the Edmond Library, 10 S. Boulevard, Edmond on Tuesdays, February 19th, February 26th, and March 4th, from 1:30 to 3:00 pm. These classes will be presented by the Child Guidance staff of the Oklahoma City-County Health Department.

Understanding their parenting style will help parents make the most of their strengths and help them to understand why others parent differently. Parents will complete a Meyers-Briggs personality inventory to help identify their personality type and receive the book “Mother Styles” – Using Personality Type to Discover Your Parenting Strengths by Janet Penley.
